# **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES**

- 1. Candidates should take their places in the examination hall at least 10 minutes before the commencement of examination.
- 2. Candidates should bring with them to the exam hall on each day of examination their hall ticket for inspection by the chief supdt/ invigilator/external examiner/internal examiner.
- 3. Candidates are prohibited from writing upon their hall tickets/question paper.
- 4. Candidates are prohibited from writing the Register number on any part of the answer book other than in the space provided in the facing sheet.
- 5. Candidates are prohibited from writing their names / improper or irrelevant remarks or signs on any part of the answer books.
- 6. Candidates are prohibited from introducing into the examination hall any books, notes, portion of book, manuscript or paper of any description. They are also prohibited from communicating with or copying from each other and from communicating with another person outside the examination hall. Violation of these rules will amount to malpractice and appropriate action will be taken in such cases.
- 7. Calculators are permitted to be used in certain subjects.
- 8. Candidates are not permitted to bring mobile phones into the examination hall.
- 9. A candidate coming late for more than 30 minutes from the commencement of examination shall not be admitted.
