<u>ORDER</u>

Government have discussed the matter of allotment of seats to Post Graduate Dental (MDS) course in Self Financing Dental Colleges and fees to be levied in the Private Self Financing Dental Colleges. A consensus regarding the fee structure for MDS Courses for the academic year 2014-15 was arrived at and an agreement has been executed with them for the admissions during 2014-2015.

In the circumstances, orders are issued regarding allocation of merit seats in the following Self Financing Dental Colleges and sanction is accorded to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for including the colleges for allotment of students for admission to Post Graduate Dental (MDS) Courses for the academic year 2014-2015, subject to the terms and conditions specified below.

- 1. Annoor Dental College & Hospital, Muvattupuzha
- 2. Azeezia College of Dental Sciences, Kollam
- 3. Royal Dental College, Chalissery
- 4. PMS College of Dental Science, Thiruvananthapuram
- 5. Mar Baselious Dental College, Kothamangalam
- 6. Sri Sankara Dental College, Varkala

7. Noorul Islam College of Dental Science ,Neyattinkara.

Terms and Conditions: -

- 1. 50% of the P.G. Dental seats sanctioned in the member colleges will be filled up by the Government from the list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in accordance with merit basis and the reservation principles followed by Government, from time to time. The annual tuition fees for this 50% merit seats will be Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs only) per annum for each student.
- 2. The Government shall furnish the list of the students to be admitted in the college by the educational agency and the educational agency concerned shall admit the students specified in the list. The students in the list will be given specific instructions as to the date and time of presentation before the college for admission, the amount of fees to be paid, and the records to be submitted at the time of admission. The educational agency shall admit the students who have complied with the instructions as certified by the Commissioner of Entrance Examination. The Commissioner of Entrance Examination shall furnish such list on or before 30th June 2014. The Managements concerned shall accept and admit the students accordingly following the above procedures but in any case not later than 5 PM on 30th June 2014. The Management concerned shall be entitled to fill those seats remaining unfilled by Government after the cut off date for admission to Government Merit Quota seats for the academic year 2014-15, subject to the condition that the forfeited seats will not be compensated during next academic year.
- 3. If any student is not admitted by any of the educational agencies for specific defects or for reasons to be recorded in writing it shall intimate the Government the defects and the Government shall rectify the defects or state the reasons for accepting the list or furnish a revised list which the educational agency shall accept and admit the students accordingly following the above procedures.

- 4. The annual fees fixed shall be inclusive of all amounts collected as in the case of similarly situated students in Government colleges. However, the educational agencies shall be entitled to collect statutorily permitted fees and such other amounts collected from similarly situated students in other colleges which shall be specifically listed out and published each year during the entire course of study. The educational agencies shall not collect any amount from any student so admitted, other than those specified below.
- 5. For the colleges under All Kerala Self Financing Dental Colleges Management Cosortium 50% of the total PG seats shall be Management quota seats to be filled by the educational agency on the basis of interse merit in the rank list of the Entrance Test MDS Courses for published by the Educational agency/Association. In the event of non availability of required number of candidates in the rank list prepared by the Educational agency/Consortium, other candidates who gualified in the All India Post Graduate Dental Entrance Examination 2014 (AIPGDEE - 2014) or any PG Dental Entrance examination 2014 conducted at national level as per DCI norms shall be admitted.50 % of the PG seats in Noorul Islam College of Dental Science shall be Management Quota Seats to be filled up by the management on the basis if AIPGDEE-2014. Out of the 50%, the Managements are entitled to fill up 15% of seats by the eligible students who are children/dependants of Non- Resident Indians, as per the conditions stipulated in GO(MS)No.34/2013/H&FWD dated 05.02.2013 and further orders in this regard if any, issued by Government from time to time. All the students under NRI Quota are exempted from qualifying in any Entrance Test and can be admitted based on their academic eligibility as stipulated by the University.
- 6. In view of the representation of the consortium with regard to the expenses incurred for establishing and administering and for further developing the infrastructure and facilities in the college, the Educational agencies shall be entitled to collect Rs.10 Lakhs (Rupees Ten Lakhs only) as annual fees from the above said 35% management quota students, during the entire course of study from each student admitted for which signed and sealed receipts shall be given. The 15% seats are reserved for NRI candidates and the fee for NRI quota shall be notified in the respective prospectus.

- 7. The seat sharing between the Educational agency and Government shall be as per the methodology fixed as per GO(Rt)No.2138/2011/H&FWD dated 02.06.2011 and GO(Rt)No.2301/2011/H&FWD dated 20.06.2011.
- 8. The Consortium / Educational agencies undertake that no consideration in cash or kind other than those specified above shall be received, accepted or collected in any form whatsoever from any student admitted to the colleges. It shall be the liability of the educational agencies to redress complaints from the students, parents or interested parties on any matter other than those covered by the terms and conditions of this agreement
- 9. The chart for distribution of seats in the Self Financing Dental colleges in the Colleges mentioned above, prepared by the Director of Medical Education based on the stipulations specified as per GO(Rt)No.2138/2011/H&FWD dated 02.06.2011 and forwarded vide letter read as 3rd paper above is approved herewith and annexured to this order.
