ORDER

Sub: Permission for starting of DM(Nephrology) for 2 seats in the Govt TD Medical college Alappuzha, Kerala from the academic year 2016-17.

Whereas Govt TD Medical college Alappuzha, Kerala applied for starting DM(Nephrology) course with 2 seats from the academic year 2016-17;

Whereas the Central Government conveyed disapproval of the scheme vide letter dated 15.06.2016 based on the recommendation of the Medical Council of India;

Whereas Sh. Mohanan C. Aruvanthara, Secretary of Pioneer Club, Allapuzha had filed a Writ Petition W.P (C) No. 23474/2016 in Hon'ble High Court of Kerala at Ernakulam for issue permission to commence 2 seats in DM(Nephrology) course in the Govt TD Medical college Alappuzha, Kerala for the academic year 2016-17;

Whereas after hearing of the parties, the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala vide its order dated 08.08.2016 has given the following direction :-

Taking the large public interest into consideration, we order that the Union of India and MCI will provisionally grant the requisite clearance and letter of permission and Kerala University of Health & Allied Sciences(KUHAS) will give provisional affiliation or permission to have the course of DM Nephrology in the Alappuzha medical college provisionally and subject to further orders in this Writ petition for 2 seats. We record the submission that there is a select list of available candidates as with the Director of Medical Education. Let the students who are taken into the course be notified at the time of admission, in writing that they are being taken on provisional basis in terms of this provisional order and that everything will be subject to final decision of this writ petition.

We are sure that the Central Government and the MCI as well as the KUHAS will have a pro-active approach, having regard to the objects sought to be achieved through this order and therefore, the MCI and Central Government will do the needful taking in consideration the letter and spirit of order, without fail, at any rate before 26.08.2016.

Now therefore, the Central Government grants provisional permission to Govt TD Medical college Alappuzha, Kerala for starting DM(Nephrology) course with 2 seats from the academic year 2016-17 with the following conditions:

- (i) The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, buildings, equipment and hospital facilities as per Medical Council of India norms.

The students who are taken into the course will be notified by the college at the time of admission, in writing that they are being taken on provisional basis in terms of this provisional order and that everything will be subject to final decision of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in W.P. No. 23474/2016 and SLP, if any, filed by MCI in the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

(iii)

Neither the petitioners nor the students will claim any equity on the basis of the provisional admission.

(iv)

Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as irregular and shall be liable for action under IMC Act, 1956 & Regulations made thereunder.
