**Notification**

The Hon'ble High Court while disposing WP(c) 15883/2011 has ordered to consider the candidature of Dr.Souja.P.P, who was disqualified under service quota for not producing the community and income certificate for claiming SEBC privilege, and issue appropriate orders.

Government examined the matter and issued orders to consider Dr.Soula.P.P for the selection process of PG Medical Courses 2011 under service quota. The benefit granted to Dr.Souja.P.P is also extended to the similarly placed service candidates.

Accordingly it is informed that service candidates who can avail the SEBC/SC/ST privilege and had secured a minimum of 40% marks in the entrance examination held on 29.05.2011 have to submit their representation before the controlling officer concerned (DHS/IMS) substantiating document to prove that they have secured more than 40% marks in the entrance examination along with the community and income certificate. SC/ST candidates are not required to submit the income certificate. The income limit for being considered for SEBC privilege is 4,50,000/-.

If such candidates do not have 4 years of service as on 05.01.2011, they are also required to forward a photocopy /printout of the application form to the controlling officer concerned. In case photocopy of the application is not readily available with the candidate, they can access the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations "<http://cee.kerala.gov.in/pgm2011/main/frame.html>" and take a printout of the existing application form.

**The following should be attached along with the application form.**

1. Demand Draft of Rs.1,000/- drawn from a Nationalized Bank in favour of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, payable at Thiruvananthapuram.
2. Service details by the Accountant General, Kerala issued after 05.01.2011.
3. Admit card issued by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Candidates are required to denote their rank in the entrance examination on the top of the application form.

The representation and application (if any) should reach the controlling officer before **03.30 pm on 25.06.2011** either by fax or hand delivery. Late and defective applications will be summarily rejected. Candidates should ensure that application has reached the concerned section of the office of the controlling officer. The controlling officer concerned will not be responsible for any delay.
