Notification

The first round allotment process of the General Merit category and Health Services Quota candidates of PG Super Speciality (DM/M.Ch) Courses 2010 was conducted on 10.08.2010. After the allotment process, 15 M.Ch seats are still remaining vacant since sufficient candidates were not available for allotting these seats as qualified candidates have not opted these seats. The details of the vacant seats are as follows.

In order to avoid lapsing of seats Government have allowed to consider candidates who have secured the minimum qualifying marks in the Paper I of the Surgical Specialities for the vacant seats on the basis of their marks secured in the Paper I. The list of candidates who had secured the minimum qualifying marks in the Paper I of the entrance examination for Surgical Super Speciality course is published in the website "www.dme.kerala.gov.in".

A provisional allotment process will be done on 17.09.2010 at 10.30 am (Friday), in the Directorate of Medical Education, situated in the Thiruvananthapuram Government Medical College campus, to fill up the vacant seats. All the candidates included in the above list can attend the allotment process. The allotment will be on the basis of the marks obtained in the Paper I of the entrance examination. However Keralites and those who have done MBBS/PG in Kerala will be given preference over other candidates.

Candidates desire to attend the counseling will have to download the prescribed format of preference form from the website "**www.dme.kerala.gov.in**".

If seats are still vacant after the allotment process on 17.09.2010, service candidates having MS General Surgery and working in Medical Education Services / Health Services / Insurance Medical Services shall be considered, if possible, the notification for which will be issued on or after 18.09.2010.
