SUPPLEMENTARY NOTIFICATION

- **1.** As per the PG Super Speciality Prospectus 2010, approved vide G.O(Rt) no.1847/2010/H&FWD dated 05.05.2010, the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations had invited application for PG Super Speciality Courses 2010 in May 2010 and the first round provisional allotment process was completed by August 10th. Sufficient qualified candidates are not available under General Merit and Service quota for 15 surgical super speciality seats. In order to avoid lapsing of seats, Government, vide letter no.18667/S3/2010/H&FWD dated 02.09.2010, has permitted to invite fresh applications from the service candidates.
- Accordingly applications are invited from candidates in Medical Education Service, Health Service and Insurance Medical Service for admission to the Post Graduate Super Speciality Courses 2010, in the Government Medical Colleges in Kerala, in the Specialities of Paediatric Surgery, Plastic Surgery and Thoracic Surgery.
- **3. Duration of the Course:** shall be **three years** from the date of commencement of the course. All candidates should complete 3 years from their date of joining.

4. Eligibility for admission:

- (a) Nativity: Applicants should be Indian Citizens.
- (b) <u>Academic Qualifications</u>: PG Degree (M.S) in General Surgery from the any of the Universities in Kerala or from any other University recognized by any of the Universities in Kerala as equivalent thereto **OR** equivalent Diploma of National Boar0d (Dip.N.B). The applicant should have acquired the PG Degree <u>as on 18.09.2010.</u>
- (c) Registration: Candidates should have got their MBBS and PG Degrees registered permanently with T.C.Medical Council and it should be submitted at the time of counseling.
- (d) <u>Age:</u> Upper age limit will be 52 years for MESQ candidates and 47 for other service candidates, <u>as on 25.09.2010</u>.
- (e) The applicant should be either regular staff under Health Services, Insurance Medical Services or Senior Lecturer/Assistant Professor under DME as on 18.09.2010.

5. Distribution of Seats

All the available seats are earmarked to Medical Education Service Quota. In case sufficient candidates are not available in MESQ, Health Service candidates will be considered and if seats are available even after considering HSQ candidates then candidates under IMS Quota will be considered.

6. Criteria for selection.

- 1. For service candidates, the eligibility will be as per the provisions of Kerala Medical Officers' Admission to Post graduate Courses under Service Quota Act 2008. Accordingly the selection of service candidates will be based on the seniority in service.
- 2. Total service will be reckoned as on 18.09.2010. <u>Unauthorised absence or absence due to Leave without Allowance (including leave on medical ground)</u> <u>will not be counted for the purpose of calculating the seniority</u>. Inter-se seniority of actual Physical service in the concerned department (concerned speciality in the case of MES), excluding LWA will be the criterion for selection. If more than one candidate applies for the course and if the difference in their length of service is below 90 days, the PSC seniority will be the criterion.

Period of leave without allowance will be deducted for determining the seniority.

- 3. For MES Quota, in case sufficient applicants from the concerned Super Speciality Department are not available, eligible candidates from other departments will be considered.
- 4. Health Service candidates will be considered for selection only if sufficient candidates are not available under MESQ and Insurance Medical Services candidates will be considered only if sufficient candidates are not available both under MESQ and HSQ.

7. How and when to apply:

Application procedure – The candidate seeking admission to the course can apply in the specific format after downloading it from the website at "www.dme.kerala.gov.in" of the Director of Medical Education. Application fee is Rs.1500/-. Application fee should be remitted in the Treasury under the Head of Account "0210-03-105-99" and the Chalan receipt should be attached with the application form. Application fee once remitted will not be refunded at any cost.

Last date and time for receipt of filled-in application forms: Candidates should download the application form, affix passport size photograph duly attested by the candidates in the space provided, and forward their filled up and completed application with all the required documents, including chalan, mentioned in clause VII (d) of the prospectus to the controlling officer concerned (<u>Director of Medical Education / Health services / Insurance Medical Services</u>), either by Registered Post, by Speed Post or Hand Delivery so as to reach her/him before 5 pm on 25.09.2010 [Saturday]. Late, defective and incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. No correspondence will be undertaken in this regard. The Controlling officers concerned will not be responsible for any postal delay.

- **8.** The controlling officer concerned will prepare the provisional rank list of candidates on the basis of service seniority.
- **9.** The selection and allotment of seats will be made by the Director of Medical Education.
- **10.** Deputation will not be allowed to Senior Lecturers/ Assistant Professors who are not working in the concerned specialities in which they have opted for admission. However the decision taken by Government in this regard will be final.
- **11.**Candidates may go through the various provisions of the Prospectus before filling up the application forms.
- **12.**The conditions as prescribed in PG Super Speciality Prospectus 2010, as approved by Government vide G.O(Rt) no.1847/2010/H&FWD dated 05.05.2010 is binding on this notification unless otherwise specified.
- **13.**The counseling for the applicants will be held on 29.09.2010 in the Directorate of Medical Education, Thriuvananthapuram at 11.00 am.
