ORDER

A number of requests has been received in Government from the students of Self Financing Medical Colleges inside and out side the state for posting as House Surgeons in Government Hospitals for Compulsory Rotating Resident Internship as part of MBBS degree programme. Government has examined the matter in detail and are pleased to issue the following clarifications.

Students from Self Financing Medical Colleges inside and out side the State will not be allowed to undergo Compulsory Rotating Resident Internship in Government Medical Colleges in the State. However the Compulsory Rotating Resident Internship posting of Self Financing College Students will be permitted in the Government Hospitals in the state under Director of Health Service, subject to the guidelines of Medical Council of India.

The maximum number of House surgeons to be posted as above in each General Hospitals/ District Hospitals will be limited to 20 or as fixed by the Government from time to time
