ORDER

Admissions to various Paramedical Courses in the State both in the Government & Self Financing Sector is governed by the minimum standards prescribed by the Kerala State Paramedical Council, comprised of Institutional standards, Students eligibility, etc. for admission to Paramedical Courses. Government of Kerala, Paramedical Council, at the time of issuance of permission to start Paramedical Courses have stipulated that 50% of seats in each sanctioned course shall be surrendered to Government. Further, the final annual consensual agreement is made in respect of the fees to be levied. The LBS, Thiruvananthapuram has been authorised as the Nodal agency to make selection and admission on behalf of Government. Students so allotted by the LBS have to register with the Kerala State Paramedical Council, with a deed of Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only). Only such registered candidates are eligible to sit the annual I & II year Examination and to undergo prescribed training conducted by the Director of Medical Education.

In the academic year 2014, some Institutions who were permitted to run such courses have taken admissions on their own accord and not surrendered 50% of seats to Government. Minimum education standard, ie. 50% marks in Plus 2 as well as mandatory reservation policy have not been observed in these cases. The LBS has furnished the list of students admitted as per the Prospectus conditions through the Director of Medical Education.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that only students admitted by the LBS and in compliance of the Prospectus conditions alone shall be registered by the Kerala Paramedical Council. All other applications are hereby rejected. The JDME (G) shall intimate the position to the concerned Institutions immediately.
